

ARTICLE XIII – AMENDMENTS

SECTION 1. Requirements. The Constitution and/or Corporate Charter may be amended by a majority vote of the qualified voters of the Nation voting at an election called for that purpose, provided, that at least thirty percent (30%) of the qualified voters as defined in this constitution actually vote in the Special Election called for that purpose.

SECTION 2. Request for an Election.

- (a) The Legislature may by law call for an election.
- (b) The citizens of the Nation may call for an election upon presentation of a petition signed by thirty percent of the qualified voters as defined in of the Nation.

ARTICLE XIV – STATUTES AND RESOLUTIONS

SECTION 1. Savings Clause. All enactments of the Tribe adopted before the effective date of this constitution shall continue in effect to the extent that they are consistent with this constitution. The Legislature shall within one year of the adoption of the constitution make the necessary enactment or amendments to any enactment inconsistent with the Constitution.
